



NELSON MANDELA MUSEUM: YOUTH & HERITAGE CENTRE, QUNU

The Nelson Mandela Youth and Heritage Centre is situated in the Eastern Cape, in the village of Qunu, where Nelson Mandela grew up. Built on the ruins of Madiba's primary school, the centre consists of community halls, craft-manufacturing buildings, an administration centre, dining hall, a museum, resource centre, restaurant and sports halls.

The Nelson Mandela Museum offers a memorable cultural experience that gives insights into the life of Nelson Mandela, with guided tours and a heritage trail that follow his footsteps.

Guided tours of the area are conducted from the Youth and Heritage Centre and include stops at the local graveyard where Madiba's three children and parents are buried, both his current and original homes, the local church, and various places important to his childhood.

Mostly the centre serves as a conference and events venue for the surrounding community. Although other companies are able to hire out the facilities, preference is always given to local events no matter how big they are.
